Rules

- 1) Age of competitors will be determined by their age as of December 31, 2018
- 2) "Provincial level" C and D divers will compete along with "Provincial Open" competitors. Separate awards will be presented
- 3) Age Group dive requirements will run in accordance to the 2017/2018 Junior National rules
- 4) Group E divers may participate in Group D1 levels as well
- 5) Dive sheet changes will be allowed up until one hour before the scheduled time of the event

Entry Fees

\$25.00 per event to a maximum of \$100.00 per diver
\$60.00 Registration fee (includes Registration fee, food hospitality and official's fee)

Scoring

We will be using Rezman scoring system. We ask that all clubs prepare the athletes dive lists using the Dive Sheet Generator at www.rezman.net. **Please submit them by email to ekdc@telus.net by Tuesday May 15th, 2018.**

Awards

Awards will be presented prior to the start of the following event. Medals will be awarded to top 3 overall as well as top 3 Albertans. Ribbons will be presented to 4th – 6th place.
All E group participants will receive awards.

Hospitality

Food will be provided to the athletes and coaches on competition days.
This includes – Breakfast, lunch and snacks.

Competition days 7:00am – 8:30am (water 7:30am – 8:30am, then closed for 1st event)

DIVE REQUIREMENTS AND RULES

Rules:

National Level

- 2017-2018 Diving Plongeon Canada rules will apply.
- Age of competitor will be determined by the diver's age as of Dec. 31, 2018.
Age Groups:
 - E - Divers born 2009 or later
 - D - Divers born 2007 or later
 - C - Divers born 2005 or 2006
 - B - Divers born 2003 or 2004
 - A - Divers born 2000 to 2002
- All events will be a straight final (no cuts).
- Senior event divers must meet the minimum DD requirement (see below)
- NO Synchronized Diving events will run due to the potential length of each day.
- Dive sheet changes will be allowed up until 1 hour before the scheduled time for that event.
- 1-metre events will run on the east side of the pool (opposite the platforms). North and South 1 metre boards will be available for training.
- A revised schedule with updated times and e-mailed out the following week after the registration deadline.

Provincial/Provincial Open events

- We will be running Provincial level and Masters level events. Please see dive requirements as per FINA masters rules or "Provincial (P1) rules"
- Provincial Open event rules for Group C and D divers are attached

Mens Open 1m	6 optional dives	13.7 Minimum
Mens Open 3m	6 optional dives	14.3 Minimum
Mens Open Platform	6 optional dives	13.7 Minimum

Synchronized Diving Events

(Please see FINA Rule Book D3.7)

NO synchro events will be running at this year's event

Junior Qualifying Competitions

- All sanctioned qualifiers must be monitored by a DPC assigned meet referee.
- There must be a minimum of 2 National level judges (not including the meet referee) on each judging panel.
- Only divers using lists adhering to the junior national dive requirements will be eligible to compete in the qualification meets.

Alberta Provincial C and D Open Rules

1. PROVINCIAL D OPEN

1.1. Age specification

1.1.1. D = 11 years old or younger in the year of competition.

1.1.2. Boys and Girls have the same dive requirements.

1.2. Group D 1m, 3m and Platform Open Event

1.2.1. Divers must perform six (6) dives selected from the Group D Open Dive Chart (Table 1)

1.2.1.1. Each of the six (6) dives must be a different dive number

1.2.1.2. For the 1m event, divers may choose either none or only one of these three dives – 202C, 302C, 402C

1.2.1.3. First four (4) dives

1.2.1.3.1. each dive will be assigned a DD of 1.6

1.2.1.3.2. Four (4) groups must be represented

1.2.1.4. Last two (2) dives

1.2.1.4.1. FINA DD used

1.2.1.4.2. Two (2) groups must be represented

2. GROUP C OPEN

2.1. Age specification

- 2.1.1. C1 = 12 or 13 years old in the year of competition
- 2.1.2. Boys and Girls have the same dive requirements

2.2. Group C 1m and 3m Open Event

- 6.2.1. Divers must perform eight (8) dives selected from the Group C Open Dive Chart (Table 2)
 - 6.2.1.1. Each of the eight (8) dives must be a different dive number
 - 6.2.1.2. First five (5) dives
 - 6.2.1.2.1. Each with a DD of 1.6
 - 6.2.1.2.2. Five (5) groups must be represented
 - 6.2.1.3. Last three (3) dives
 - 6.2.1.3.1. FINA DD used
 - 6.2.1.3.2. Three (3) groups must be represented
 - 6.2.1.3.3. A minimum of one (1) dive must be from Group 100 or 400
 - 6.2.1.3.4. A minimum of one (1) dive must be from Group 200 or 300

2.3. Group C Platform Open Event

- 2.3.1. Divers must perform seven (7) dives selected from the Group C Open Dive Chart (Table 2)
 - 2.3.1.1. Each of the seven (7) dives must be a different dive number
 - 2.3.1.2. Five (5) groups must be represented in the seven (7) dives
 - 2.3.1.3. First four (4) dives
 - 2.3.1.3.1. Each with a DD of 1.6
 - 2.3.1.3.2. Four (4) groups must be represented
 - 2.3.1.4. Last three (3) dives
 - 2.3.1.4.1. FINA DD used
 - 2.3.1.4.2. Three (3) groups must be represented
 - 2.3.1.4.3. A minimum of one (1) dive must be from Group 100 or 400
 - 2.3.1.4.4. A minimum of one (1) dive must be from Group 200 or 300
