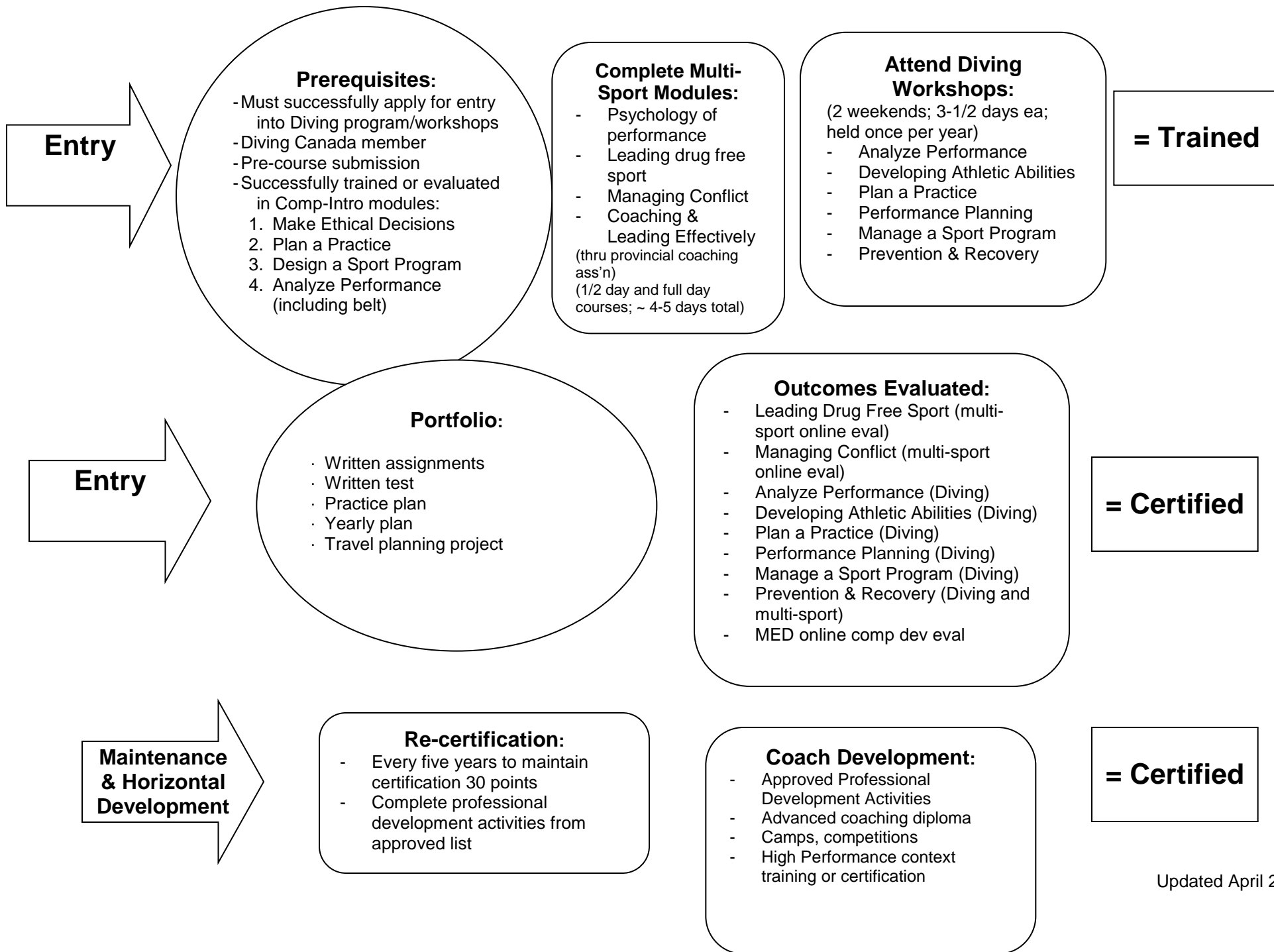


Diving Competition-Development Coach Pathway



Entry

Prerequisites:

- Must successfully apply for entry into Diving program/workshops
- Diving Canada member
- Pre-course submission
- Successfully trained or evaluated in Comp-Intro modules:
 1. Make Ethical Decisions
 2. Plan a Practice
 3. Design a Sport Program
 4. Analyze Performance (including belt)

Complete Multi-Sport Modules:

- Psychology of performance
- Leading drug free sport
- Managing Conflict
- Coaching & Leading Effectively (thru provincial coaching ass'n) (1/2 day and full day courses; ~ 4-5 days total)

Attend Diving Workshops:

- (2 weekends; 3-1/2 days ea; held once per year)
- Analyze Performance
 - Developing Athletic Abilities
 - Plan a Practice
 - Performance Planning
 - Manage a Sport Program
 - Prevention & Recovery

Maintenance & Horizontal Development

Re-certification:

- Every five years to maintain certification 30 points
- Complete professional development activities from approved list

Coach Development:

- Approved Professional Development Activities
- Advanced coaching diploma
- Camps, competitions
- High Performance context training or certification
